Hello Fellow Curlers.

While I know that most of your thoughts are on other things and not curling, I am sending this email to update you on what has happened at the club this Summer and touch on a few things happening during the upcoming season.

I am pleased to advise that all staff will remain in place - Doug and Carol Murray as General Managers, Myles Chapin as Head Ice Technician, Lonnie Karpick and Doug Murray as Ice Technicians and Sue Curiston in the Concession. We have a great team, and it is wonderful to see them all returning.

We have had an eventful Summer with several rentals and a huge thank you goes out to Doug and Carol who "volunteered" their time to assist with these.

Several large maintenance projects were undertaken this Summer including:

- Replacement of three quarters of our roof. We have applied for a Gaming capital grant for 50% of the final one quarter and (fingers crossed) anticipate its replacement during the Spring of 2025.
- Replacement of the pump for our ice system.
- Replacement and painting of the front entry doors.
- Replacement of the on-ice benches.
- Cleaning and painting in and around the Club including the boards surrounding the ice surface, interior doors, most walls and all the trim around the windows.

Thank you to all the volunteers who assisted with these projects.

Unfortunately, we were not successful in our grant application to upgrade the bathrooms but we have submitted another grant request for this project and hope to be able to complete them in the near future.

We have also submitted a grant application for an accessibility lift. This would be a huge project (rough estimate at approximately \$200,000) that would require architectural drawings, structural assessments and more detailed construction quotes. We will keep you updated.

GOOD NEWS - we were successful in obtaining an annual operating grant from the BC Community Gaming Grants Branch. We requested an increase to our annual amount of \$32,000 and have been awarded \$40,000 for this year. This increase is very much appreciated as our annual operating costs, like everything in our world these days, have increased substantially.

BC 55 Plus Games:

With Salmon Arm hosting the BC 55 Plus Games in just over a week, the ice is going in as I type this. The Games will be held September 10 to 14 and we have 32 teams registered from all over the province in 6 categories. There are 4 Salmon Arm teams curling in the event and the doors are open so come on down and see our "senior" curlers in action. Games will run from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Wednesday and Thursday, 8:00 am to 3:30 pm on Friday (with tiebreakers following if necessary). The Bronze Medal games will be played on Saturday morning beginning at 8:00 am with the Gold Medal games following at 11:00 am.
